



Collegedale Academy Information for 2009-2010

Early Application Process:

All new students may reserve space for the 2009-2010 school year beginning February 1, 2009. A NON-REFUNDABLE application fee of \$25 is required. An application fee of \$75 is required March-May. June-August is \$100. We hope that you will be able to make an early decision for the coming school year.

Academy Day

Is April 21, 2009 and all new students for 2009-2010 are invited. All local SDA elementary schools attend. If your student does not attend a local SDA elementary school, please just give us a call so that a name tag may be prepared.

Placement Testing

Eighth grade students attending local SDA elementary schools will be tested for math placement. Those taking Algebra I in 8th grade will be required to take the Algebra I challenge test in order to receive credit at the academy level. Testing arrangements should be made with Mr. Dave Djernes.

Incoming 9th Grader Academy Policy

This policy concerns incoming freshman with low grades, and we want you to be aware of it if you do decide to apply to Collegedale Academy:

Our policy reads:

Incoming 9th graders with F's in English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, or Social Studies will be required to complete remedial education through a certified learning center (Sylvan or Honors) in order to be considered for acceptance to Collegedale Academy.

Course Selection:

Chaplain Litchfield and Mr. Djernes are the recruiters for the spring/summer. They will contact new students after applications have been received, or you may call them. They will then arrange a visit either at your home or the school to discuss course choices and other programs at CA. These visits will take place throughout the summer.
