

WELLNESS:

My student chose to take Acro Force instead of Wellness his/her 9th grade year. How does that credit get earned?

Wellness is 1 semester of PE and 1 semester of health. Students must have 5 semesters of PE to graduate. Students must have at least .5 (one semester) of health.

CA recommends The Keystone School*:

Course: Health/Nutrition and Wellness Online. Select the first semester option.

STUDY SKILLS/GEOGRAPHY:

My student chose to take two fine arts and didn't take Study Skills/Geography his/her 9th grade year. How does that credit get earned?

Study Skills is a one semester course worth .5 credit in the Practical Arts/Technology department (this is NOT fine arts). Students must have 1.5 credits in Practical Arts/Technology to graduate. Study Skills itself does not have to be taken, but another course in Practical Arts/Technology of at least .5 credit must be taken before graduation. Other courses in this department include Advanced Woodworking, Home Maintenance, Digital Lifestyle, and Multi-media Design.

Geography is a one semester course worth .5 credit. Students need this .5 credit in social studies to graduate.

CA recommends The Keystone School*:
Geography Online. Select either 1st or 2nd semester option.

As you select, ask which one your student already may know more about or needs to review and/or learn for the first time?

Semester 1: North America, Central and South America, Western Europe
Semester 2: Eastern Europe, East Asia, Southeast Asia and Pacific, Africa, India and the Middle East

*Other accredited online schools: Alpha Omega Academy, A Beka Academy (accredited option only), Griggs Academy (SDA), Sycamore Academy (accredited option).
