

# JUNIOR COURSES

1. **Sign In to PowerSchool. USE SAFARI, NOT THE POWERSCHOOL APP.** <https://ca-net.powerschool.com> Use your CA login and password.
2. **Class Registration Icon—open until May 31—can make changes until then**
3. **Click on tiny box with pencil inside (right side of screen) for course lists.**
4. **The ! means you must select something from that subject area. Ignore green and red marks.**
5. **You have room during the day for 8 classes plus chapel and Service III.** Everything else must be after school. You must have at least 6 classes.

## REQUIRED COURSES:

- 1** Religion III, **2** English III, Service III, chapel—computer will assign these automatically.

Everyone needs 20 hours of community service **per year** at C.A. to graduate. Service III is the junior course to record this community service.

- 3 Math**—You must take a math every year! You should have your Algebra I credit by now.

Mrs. Beasley=AP Statistics/Calculus. Mrs. Andersen=Pre-Cal

- o Geometry>Algebra II or Technical Algebra II. (with period at end of name, not for C.A. Scholars or Pre-Cal)
- o Algebra II>Pre-Cal **or** AP Statistics
- o Pre-Cal>AP Calculus or AP Statistics

### Pre-Calculus Requirements:

- o 1. A or B grade in Algebra II.
- o 2. Completion of non-technical track Alg. 1, Geometry, and Alg. 2.
- o 3. Teacher recommendations/approval from math department.
- o 4. ACT Math score of 19 or greater and highly motivated students who have completed regular Algebra II with a strong performance.

### AP Statistics Requirements:

Prerequisite: ACT Math score of 19 or greater and highly motivated students who have completed regular Algebra II with a strong performance.

## **4 Science:**

Advanced GeoScience>Biology>Chemistry or Physics

Chemistry>Physics or A & P

*Need only 3 sciences for College Preparatory Diploma:* Biology, Chemistry **OR** Physics, plus another: Advanced GeoScience

*C.A. Scholars:* Adv. GeoScience, Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Anatomy and Physiology (A & P can be for college credit or just C.A. credit).

## **5 History:**

U.S. History

If you are taking during the summer, please tell Miss Conerly. Write a note on this paper, with your name, and give to Miss Conerly.

If taking during the summer, will you take Gov/Econ next year? Make sure to sign up for both! Spaces are limited and seniors get preference for Gov/Econ next year.

## **6 Grade 11--Foreign Language: (necessary for College Prep. or C.A. Scholars)**

>College Preparatory Diploma or C.A. Scholars: Must take 2 years of same foreign language.

- o Spanish I or II
- o French I - 2017-2018, French II - 2018-2019

## **CHOICES for classes 7 & 8:**

### **Fine Art:**

You need 2 full credits to graduate.

Music is Western Culture is .5 credit only—as a junior you must have a 3.5 G.P.A. to take it for college credit.

Band, Chamber Orchestra, Bella Voce, Drawing/Painting, FrontMen, Opus, Sculpture (each 1 full credit per year), Color and Design, Art Appreciation.

Jazz Band may only be taken in conjunction with concert band.

### **PE:**

5 semesters of PE required for graduation **includes year of Wellness (5 semesters of PE total plus one semester of health). You must take 2.5 years of PE total.**

### **Technology/Practical Arts: (1.0 credits required)**

Need 1.0 credit to graduate.

Example: Study Skills = .5 then one semester of any of these:

Digital Lifestyle, Home Maintenance, Life Skills, Advanced Woodworking, new ACT/Career/computer course(s)
