

SENIOR COURSES

1. **Sign In to PowerSchool. USE SAFARI, NOT THE POWERSCHOOL APP. <https://ca-net.powerschool.com> Use your CA login and password.**
2. **Class Registration Icon—open until May 31—can make changes until then**
3. **Click on tiny box with pencil inside (right side of screen) for course lists.**
4. **The ! means to select from that subject area. Ignore other marks of green, etc.**
5. You have room during the day for **3** classes plus chapel and Service IV.
6. **You must have at least 6 courses per semester at CA.**

REQUIRED COURSES:

1 Religion IV, Service IV, chapel—computer will assign these automatically. Service IV and chapel are not part of the 8 total courses possible in the school day. Everyone needs 20 hours of community service per year at C.A. to graduate. Service IV is the senior course to record this community service

2 **ENGLISH IV or Composition 101/102:** If you have a 3.0 gpa you may take dual enrollment courses Sign up for Composition 101 and 102 (both) if you are interested in taking it. *If your ACT scores don't qualify, you will automatically be moved to English IV. ACT scores after April will be accepted as space allows. Test scores from December, February and then April get first requests.*

Required for Comp (all 4!):

1. 3.0 gpa
2. ACT score in English of at least 23
3. ACT scores in Writing of at least 7 in all writing categories.
4. B+ average in previous English courses.

3 **Math**—You must take a math **EACH YEAR** in high school.

Geometry>Algebra II or Technical Algebra II. (with period at end of name--not for C.A. Scholars or Pre-Cal)

- o Algebra II>Statistics or Pre-Cal. **Pre-Cal will be by recommendation of the math department.** See below
- o Technical Algebra II>AP Statistics or senior math.
- o Pre-Cal>AP Calculus

- **Bridge Math - students in Technical Algebra 2 and Math ACT <= 16**
- **Statistics (regular) - Pre-requisites: Regular Algebra 2 with "C" in 1st and 2nd semesters. Tech. Alg. 2: "A" 1st & 2nd sem.**
- **AP Statistics: Pre-requisites: Regular Algebra 2 with "B" in 1st and 2nd semester and Math ACT >= (greater and equal to) 19 and teacher recommendation.**

- **Pre-Calculus: Pre-requisites: Regular Algebra 2 with "B" in 1st and 2nd semester and Math ACT >= 19 and teacher recommendation.**
- **AP Calculus: Pre-requisites: Pre-Calculus with "B" in 1st and 2nd semester and teacher recommendation.**

4 **Science:**

- o You should already have Biology credit!
- o Chemistry>Physics or A & P
- o Physics>Anatomy and Physiology (need 3.0 gpa for college credit)
- *Need only 3 sciences for College Preparatory Diploma: Science Concepts, Biology, Chemistry OR Physics, plus one other science*
- *C.A. Scholars: Science Concepts, Biology, Chemistry, Physics or Anatomy and Physiology (must have 3.0 gpa)*

5 **History:**

American Government & Economics. Make sure to sign up for both!

6 **Personal Finance: (.5 credit) / _____ opposite semester?**

All students must take to graduate. One semester course, offered each semester -- Life Skills or Music in Western Culture could be the other semester.

7 **Foreign Language: (necessary for College Prep. or C.A. Scholars)**

>College Preparatory Diploma or CA Scholars: Must take 2 years of same foreign language.

- o Spanish II
- o French II

8 **Other possible classes or requirements for your situation :**

Fine Art: your choice, need 2 full credits to graduate

Band, Chamber Orchestra, Bella Voce, Drawing/Painting, Opus, Sculpture, **Music in Western Culture requires 3.0 gpa for dual enrollment. 3 hours of college credit, .5 credit at CA for fine arts requirement.** Color and Design, Art Appreciation. Jazz Band must be taken in conjunction with concert band.

PE:

5 semesters of PE required for graduation with Wellness (so 5 semesters of PE and 1 semester of health). You must take 2.5 years of PE. Ind. PE is for scheduling conflicts and medical issues ONLY.

Technology/Practical Arts: (1.0 credit required)

Need 1.0 credit to graduate.

Example: Study Skills = .5 then one semester of any of these: P.A.C.E., Home Maintenance, Life Skills, and Advanced Woodworking
