ACT REGISTRATION FOR COLLEGEDALE ACADEMY (HIGH SCHOOL)

Registration for ACT is online: www.actstudent.org

The Plus Writing test is optional **UNLESS** students plan to take Composition (Comp) 101/102 at the high school, which is a dual enrollment course.

Codes for registering:

- 1. CA High School Code **430400**. This informs ACT your student is a Collegedale Academy High School student.
- 2. CA High School Test Center Code **184726**. This code confirms that testing will move from Saturday to Friday.

Once the registration is paid (only by Credit Card) print off the Admission Ticket. The ticket will show Friday as the national test date not Saturday. If it does not or if there is a problem, you need to contact ACT directly (1-800-553-6244 x1270) and speak to a rep about the issue.

Be aware of the following:

- Pay close attention to registration deadlines.
- Inputting CA's Test Center Code (184726) changes the Saturday test to the Friday test date.
- Students are required to upload a self-photo for the testing identification. Both Android and Apple App stores have the ACT Photo App, which makes this process easier.
- It is important to print out the admission ticket, as this is one of the documents students need to be allowed into the testing room on the day of testing.
- Students may take the ACT up to 12 times.
- SAU's Counseling and Testing Center offers a non-national ACT testing if students want to
 practice taking the ACT without the score going on their transcript. Contact the Counseling
 and Testing Center for more information 423-236-2782.

The High School offers the ACT four times per year and the dates are on Fridays, one day before the dates listed. Since ACT scores are important the High School will reimburse juniors only the February testing fee.

ACT ADMISSIONS INFORMATION:

All students taking the ACT will need the following for admittance into ACT testing rooms:

- 1. Student's name and photo listed on the official ACT roster. A seating chart will be posted on the wall by the Guidance Office a week prior to testing. If the student's name is not listed contact Mr. Djernes ASAP.
- 2. Printed ACT Admission Ticket -- print this out before test date.
- 3. Proper photo ID Driver's License, Passport, School ID, State ID, or ACT letter

If a student does not have all of the above, they will not be admitted to take the ACT.

Once admitted into the testing room it is the students' responsibility to have the following:

- 1. Several #2 pencils with erasers.
- 2. Approved ACT calculator (working order, extra batteries, a backup calculator).
- 3. Food and water are not allowed in the testing rooms.

Other helpful information:

HOPE Scholarship - Seniors (TN residents) to receive the HOPE must have the following:

- 1. 3.00 GPA or higher OR
- 2. ACT composite score of 21 or higher.

(Seniors who do not have a minimum GPA of 3.00 must get a minimum ACT composite score of 21).

- 3. Completion of the FASA. This is the application for the HOPE.
- 4. Supply student's Social Security Number.

Note: If the high school does not have students Social Security numbers in the PowerSchool. HOPE verification cannot happen and the student will not receive the Scholarship.

Upcoming seniors (current juniors) wanting to take Comp 101/02 at the high school their senior year must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. 3:00 GPA or higher
- 2. "B" or higher in junior English
- 3. Score a 23 or higher on the ACT English test portion
- 4. Scores a 7 or higher on **each** of the subsets on the ACT Plus Writing.
