Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to next year with your children. We want to inform you of the 6th grade outdoor education experience.

It will soon be time for us to begin planning our trip to Wesley Woods that will take place Sept. 18-20. This is a great trip that the 6th grade participates in every year, and we hope your child will be excited about it. For those of you who may not be familiar with this trip, let me give you a brief explanation.

Our school has been involved in this outdoor education experience since the 1970's. Originally, the destination was "Land between the Lakes". Since 1986, we have been going to "Wesley Woods", located near the Smoky Mountains. For three days, the students will be immersed in activities surrounded by the great outdoors. They interact tangibly with the environment and spend time promoting their own personal growth. This includes both team building and challenge courses.

The cost for this trip is \$170 for each student and \$110 for each adult.

STUDENTS - A deposit of \$70 will be due by August 19. The second payment of \$50 will be due August 30 and the final \$50 payment on September 13. Please make sure all forms are turned in by August 30. Payment can be made in full at anytime.

PARENTS - Parents wishing to attend must make arrangements through Mrs. Tatum and Ms. Guider. Space is limited. **Please do not plan to come if you cannot be with us the full 3 days.**
