- **Senior English:** Juniors wishing to take dual enrollment Composition 101/102 their senior year must earn a 23 on the multiple choice English test and all 7's or better on the four writing scores. The writing test is required. The benchmark is high due to omitting English IV completely.
- **Senior Math:** Dual Enrollment Statistics and Pre-Calculus require a 19 or better on the mathematics test.

POWERSCHOOL PORTAL SETTINGS—emergency alert system contacts and grade emails

Please make sure to check your contact settings in the PowerSchool portal. Once you set up your PowerSchool account:

1. Click on SwiftReach/Swift12 (upper left)
2. Click on "Contact Information" in the upper right banner
3. Check that those areas are filled in correctly
4. Click on "Alert Preferences" (upper right banner again)
5. Select the ways you prefer to receive alerts

The mobile app: if grades are not showing, try uninstalling and re-installing the app on your phone. The district code is WXBH.
