Hot Lunches at Collegedale Academy for grades 9-12 Homecooked Meals & Class Expenses Fundraiser

Each student has the option of purchasing a hot lunch at Collegedale Academy each day.

Meals are \$5 each and are purchased during lunch time.

Lunch cards may be purchased in sets of 10 at the business office.

Students may choose to bring their lunch if that is their preference.

- The hot lunch program serves as a fund raiser and is primarily supported by parent volunteers.
- The proceeds of the hot lunch program help offset each class' expenses, including senior class trip.
- Each day of the week is assigned to a particular class. Volunteers help prepare lunch for that week.
- Parents from each class volunteer to help **cook**, **shop**, **or coordinate** the class's volunteers.
- Each class has a lead parent volunteer who coordinates the volunteers from a class to cook, shop, and other needs for each meal.
- **All parents' help is encouraged and welcomed**. The range of how often parents can help is wide, ranging from a time or two each semester to once a week.
- The number of volunteers needed for the preparation of the weekly lunch is determined by the intricacy of the meal and lead hot lunch volunteer.
- By the senior year, the hot lunch fundraiser has typically provided at least 50% of the senior class expenses.
- In general, our hot lunches and other class fundraisers defray the individual student costs of the senior class trip from over \$1000 to \$300 -\$350 out-of-pocket ("cash cost") per student.
- Starting in 2021, volunteer incentives will be available to help defray the "cash cost" of their student's senior class trip. See the "Volunteer Incentives Parameters" document for details. Note: volunteers must fall into the "consistent" and "regular" categories to be eligible for the incentive, with opportunities available all years of a student's fulltime enrollment at CA.
