Power School Instructions on How to Add Multiple Children to your Account

1. Log on to your existing account or create a *new account
2. Click on Account Preferences (left side column at the bottom)
3. Click on the 'Student' Tab
4. Click on 'Add' (Right side)
5. Type in the student's name, access ID, access password, and choose the relationship (This information was sent in a letter previously)
6. Click submit after adding each additional sibling to complete the process
7. Please let us know if you need help. ☺

*(once account is created for first child follow the directions to add additional children)

Student Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

Parents may drop-off/pick-up their children at the respective doors. If you need to meet with your child's teacher, you may go down after 3:15. Kindergarten parents may continue to walk to their child's classroom for the remainder of this week. Next week they will need to follow the above procedures. Early Childhood parents are required by the state to sign their children in/out at the classroom.
