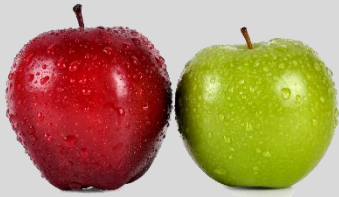

Parent Volunteers

Due to Covid restrictions these options have been limited but as we begin to resume these activities, we want to make sure you have completed the necessary steps. Parent volunteers are required to complete our Adventist Volunteer Training and complete our Code of Conduct form to be permitted to help in the classroom or attend field trips.

To access the Adventist Volunteer Training:

1. Go to Collegedaleacademy.com click on “forms and resources”
2. Scroll under “Elementary” click on “volunteer training”
 - Select: FIRST TIME REGISTRANT
 - Scroll down and select: TN – Tennessee
 - Scroll down and select: GEORGIA-CUMBERLAND CONFERENCE
 - Create user id and password
 - Please read the instructions regarding the details of the online training and then proceed. Select CLICK HERE TO START to begin,
 - Note; Training can take up to one hour

Volunteer training is only valid for 3 years. Please do this as soon as possible as background checks can take several days to process. If you plan to chaperone a field trip submit the following in addition to completing the volunteer training. Copy of Driver’s License, only if driving Copy of Car Insurance, only if driving. ALL CHAPERONES MUST BE CLEARED THROUGH THE OFFICE BEFORE ATTENDING A FIELD TRIP.

- Please pull forward as far as possible during drop off/pick up and continue to do so as a spot opens.
- K – 2nd grade parents, PLEASE pass the first entrance and have your child walk to/from it if there is space.
- The middle lane is drive through only. Do not let your child enter/exit while in the middle lane.
- If you need to come into the school, park in a designated parking space past the main entrance.
- **Stay off your phones** while in the school zone as it is not only dangerous it is against the law.
- Just a reminder, there is no left turn into the parking lot during drop off/pick up. Please respect this even when the flashing lights aren't working.
- Students unloading on the parking lot side need to cross at a designated yellow crosswalk with the assistance of the faculty member on duty.
