Parents may change their usernames/passwords. Under email notifications, you select how often you wish to receive email notifications and how detailed the grade and attendance reports will be.

**Power School Instructions on How to Add a Sibling**

Log on to your account

Click on Account Preferences (left side column at the bottom)

Click on the 'Student' Tab

Click on 'Add' (Right side)

Type in the student's name, access ID, access password, and choose the relationship (This information was sent in a letter previously)

Click 'OK'

Your child's name should show up on the top with your other child

**POWERSCHOOL PORTAL SETTINGS—emergency alert system contacts and grade emails**

Please make sure to check your contact settings in the PowerSchool portal. Once you set up your PowerSchool account:

1. Click on SwiftReach/Swift12 (upper left)
2. Click on "Contact Information" in the upper right banner
3. Check that those areas are filled in correctly
4. Click on "Alert Preferences" (upper right banner again)
5. Select the ways you prefer to receive alerts

Click "Email Notification" on the left side for PowerSchool email settings for grades/attendance alerts.

**The mobile app:** if grades are not showing, try uninstalling and re-installing the app on your phone. The district code is WXBH. Don't yet have the mobile app? Go to your app store and look for PowerSchool Mobile with this logo. Make sure to get the dark background.
