No lunches are sold that week. Students are given extra time in the afternoons for study.

If a student has a study hall, they are not required to attend but should be off campus or may work if s/he is a teacher's reader. **If a student is on campus during the assigned study hall and not working for a**

teacher, then study hall attendance is required. Students are expected to be in regular CA uniform dress code and have their CA ID cards throughout exam week.

SEMESTER WITHDRAWALS

If you foresee your student withdrawing from CA at the semester, the following must be returned/cleared before an official transcript may be issued to another school:

- computer & all passwords/codes for it; cord & charger block
- cleaned locker
- course books returned: textbooks and paperbacks issued
- library books/fines
- athletic uniform/gear returned
- music folders/instruments returned
- clearance from the business office

CHANGING COURSES/SWITCHING SECTIONS

Most students will not need to change their schedules for second semester. However, if your student does need to add/drop a course, the semester is the time to do so. Students have two weeks to make schedule changes. - **Senior English:** Juniors wishing to take dual enrollment Composition 101/102 their senior year must earn a 23 on the multiple-choice English test and all 7's or better on the four writing scores. The writing test is required. The benchmark is high due to omitting English IV completely.
- **Senior Math:** Dual Enrollment Statistics and Pre-Calculus require a 19 or better on the mathematics test.

Power School Instructions on How to Add a Sibling

Log on to your account

Click on Account Preferences (left side column at the bottom)

Click on the ‘Student’ Tab

Click on ‘Add’ (Right side)

Type in the student’s name, access ID, access password, and choose the relationship (This information was sent in a letter previously)

Click ‘OK’

Your child’s name should show up on the top with your other child

POWERSCHOOL PORTAL SETTINGS—emergency alert system contacts and grade emails

Please make sure to check your contact settings in the PowerSchool portal. Once you set up your PowerSchool account:

1. Click on SwiftReach/Swift12 (upper left)
2. Click on “Contact Information” in the upper right banner
3. Check that those areas are filled in correctly
4. Click on “Alert Preferences” (upper right banner again)
5. Select the ways you prefer to receive alerts

Click “Email Notification” on the left side for PowerSchool email settings for grades/attendance alerts.

The mobile app: if grades are not showing, try uninstalling and re-installing the app on your phone. The district code is WXBH. Don’t yet have the mobile app? Go to your app store and look for PowerSchool Mobile with this logo. Make sure to get the dark background.
