Middle and High School Parents

The HS is hosting Dean Sikes Ministry on March 2 for **Middle & HS students and parents**. Here is a brief bio of the "You Matter" program: Since January 1, 1993, Dean Sikes has been a voice of hope to teenagers across America and in nations around the world. Our mission is simple: Ours is a voice of hope called to inspire teenagers from all walks of life with this truth: You were created as an original; you were created for relationship; and you were created to fulfill a purpose. Our message is likewise simple and to the point: Because you're breathing, YOU MATTER. We want every teenager, everywhere, to have the opportunity to hear, to consider, and to then respond to our message and to its truth. During our first three decades of fulfilling our mission in high schools and Teen Challenge Centers, Dean shared our message of hope at over 3,800 events, reaching over 2.6 million teens. At these assemblies and chapels, we've seen over 288,000 students give their hearts to the Lord and to date, over 100,000 students have signed our I MATTER Pledge. We never charge anyone, anything, and our outreach is debt-free. When it comes to our FOLLOW-UP, we lean heavily upon our resources that we freely offer to teenagers via our [YOU MATTER.US](https://youmatter.us) website; resources comprised of over thirty books Dean has written for teens and their families, including a daily devotional for youth entitled: HOPE 365©. Also serving as an integral part of our follow up are our daily videos that are deployed to multiple social media platforms every day of the year. To date, we've had over 2.5 million views of our videos online. And the final part of our follow up is our YOU MATTER TELEVISION broadcast - a national, weekly television program that airs on multiple networks as well as our YOUTUBE channel. Dean and Lori Sikes were married in May of 1996. They have three adult children and four dogs. Although their ministry schedule takes them into multiple cities across America each week, they continue to make their home in Chattanooga, Tennessee.
