Parent Town Hall Meeting – April 24th 6:30 pm at High School

The goal of this meeting is to listen to concerns, suggestions for improvement, and listen to each other. The chair of our E-12 safety committee, Stacie Schepers, and myself will take notes and/or ask clarifying questions. We will also share, to an extent (we simply do not want to make all our safety plan public knowledge as this could potentially help an intruder), what steps CA has taken over the past five years to become safer as a school. Stacie and I will collate the information gathered, in order to present to our CA school board. The school board can then wrestle with prioritizing safety needs and the associated costs. Once these goals are set, they will be given to the Head of School/Administrative Team for implementation.
