Academics

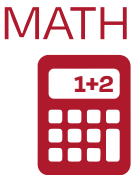
Collegedale Academy offers a stringent curriculum in order to prepare students for the academic rigor they will encounter in college. This curriculum begins with our Early Childhood Education Center and goes through to the upper classes in high school where students choose from a variety of classes that will prepare them for their next step in education.

Test Results

Measures of Academic Progress

CA uses Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) standardized test for kindergarten to Grade 8 and are expanding to include high school next year.

These assessments are useful because it gives us a thorough picture of student learning. It adapts to each student's ability, accurately measuring what a child knows. In addition, MAP tests measure academic growth over time, independent of grade level or age. Most importantly, the results have practical application to help educators understand where students need the most help. CA's MAP scores continue to land well above the U.S. average. However, we continually seek ways that we can improve. We have a taskforce dedicated to reviewing our scores to identify patterns, where extra resources are needed which guides instructional planning and school improvement.

College Assessments

Our graduation rate is 98% with approximately 96% of our graduates going on to two or four year college and university programs.

ACT Results

CA's class of 2022 scored an ACT composite average of 23.7 (writing, reading, math, science). In the state of Tennessee, the average score was 19.8. In the United States, the average ACT score was 21.0. CA's unique commitment is to standardized test every student, irrespective of academic achievement or future goals.

College Prep - Advanced Classes

CA's Advance Placement (AP) program offers college-level curricula and examinations to high school students. Students are offered several advanced learning options: Advanced Placement (AP) classes, College Level (CL) credit classes, and Dual Credit (DC) classes through Southern Adventist University.

Seven Seniors in AP Calculus – Average GPA was 3.81

Exam scores showed – 6 of 7 passing with a 3 or better

21 Juniors in AP US History – Average GPA was 3.64

18 took exam - 14 of 18 passing with a 3 or better

25 Seniors took Composition 101/102 (DC) – All students passed with an average GPA of 3.83

25 Seniors took Statistics (CL) – All students passed with an average GPA of 3.81

13 Seniors in CA scholar projects

25 Seniors in National Honor Society

55 students in national Math society – Mu Alpha Theta

Looking Ahead

After years of planning, Collegedale Academy is moving forward with plans for a new elementary building with a \$25,000,000 fundraising goal. This is a major project which will complete the elementary school campus at the site of the middle school built in 2010. The new facility will replace the present 64-year-old building. In anticipation of this new facility, we have been working to invite community support through a capital campaign, *Inspire Now and for Eternity*, focused on this project alone.

Christian education is one of our church's greatest evangelism tools that we have. The elementary school is the "front door" of our entire church and educational system. According to a recent study*, if we do not attract families in our Adventist schools, they are 13 times more likely to never be active in a Seventh-day Adventist church so we have made the youngest students our top priority this year.

This project will bring our campus together, modernize and enhance facilities for the early childhood – 5th grade students, and provide opportunities for closer collaboration and greater efficiencies. We expect to begin construction on the building in December 2023 and plan to be ready to open for school in August 2025.

Finally, we are still in the early stages of our campaign efforts and there is much more to come. Everyone will be invited to join the effort – parents, grandparents, alumni, church members, corporations, and our entire community. Parent Survey Results 2022


Collegedale Academy is committed to continuous school improvement. As part of this process, an annual parent survey is sent out for parents to reflect on areas of strength and areas of growth at the school. Gaining this valuable knowledge is key in our desire for improvement and setting plans for our CA Strategic Plan.

Once the surveys have been collected, our building leadership teams (E-5, 6-8, 9-12) and administration analyze the data gathered. Common themes and trends rise to the top, with that information helping to set priorities for the upcoming school year. An example of this would be last year, when many parents requested a full-time Safety Resource Officer on campus.

Currently our CA Policy Committee, a committee of the CA School Board, and school administration is reviewing our survey to ensure the gathering of appropriate information.

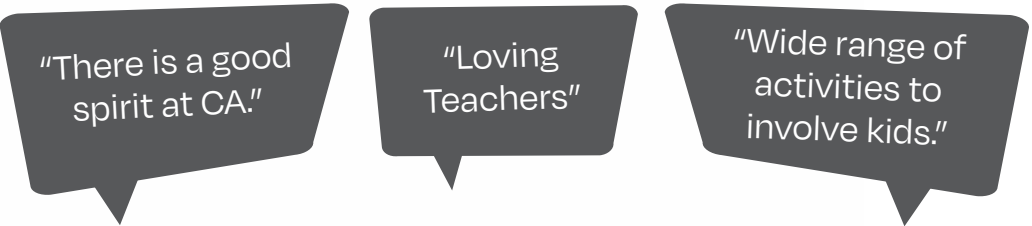
