2024-25 School Year Applications: *Please note Re-Enrollment information below*

Applications are now open for new and current students in Early Childhood (preschool aged) – grade 12. Note: Early bird application fee (\$75) is open from Jan – March 31. The regular application fee (\$100) begins April 1.

With a completed application, a spot in the upcoming year's class will be held for returning students, until Jan 31. On Feb 1 all applicants, new and returning, will acquire a class spot in the date order of their completed application. Class spots are secured once acceptance letters are sent to each student.
