



GCC Music Festival for Advanced Band and Orchestra

CA Middle Advanced Band and Strings have the opportunity to participate in the GCC music festival held at Georgia-Cumberland Academy. The festival is on Thursday and Friday, January 25th-26th. The students have been looking forward to and working hard for the event all year, and we are excited to have everyone attend. We will load the bus on Thursday at 2:30 pm and head down to GCA for registration, supper, and our first rehearsals. After rehearsals, we will return to the CA campus by about 9:30 pm on Thursday.
