Tomorrow, Noon Dismissal - Reunification In-Service

All of Collegedale Academy will be dismissed at noon this Friday, February 2nd. Students will not have lunch. They will be dismissed as usual and can walk or be picked up in the car line. Aftercare will not be provided on Friday, February 2nd. We will close early so all faculty members can participate in the critical safety training.

Reunification Practice for Wednesday's Dismissal

On Wednesday, February 7, the middle school student body will be relocated to the University Church to practice our reunification procedures. Student pickup will not be at the middle school but at the University Church instead, starting at 3 pm.

If a catastrophic event were to happen and relocation of students was necessary, we would ask two things from parents. For this drill on February 7, we are asking the same.

- 1. Bring a photo ID- Driver's license, state ID, etc.
- 2. **Be patient** You must park your vehicle in the upper parking lot, get out, and stand in line by the church to show your ID and then wait for your child to be brought out to you.

As a parent, if you cannot pick up your child due to work, etc, please have someone on your student's emergency contact list, pick up your child. If this were an actual emergency event, students would be released to custodial parents only.

The Middle School staff will relocate the student body to the church at 2:30 pm. The students can take their belongings since this is only a drill. Parents may pick up students at the church at 3:00 pm. All students need to be picked up by 3:45 pm. Walkers will be released at 3:15. Students with work commitments or sports practices after school will be walked back to the middle school at the appropriate time. Thank you in advance for your cooperation in helping us keep our student body as safe aspossible. We appreciate you marking your calendars for both events.


