Applications are now open for new and current students in Early Childhood (preschool-aged) – grade 12. Note: Early bird application fee (\$75) is available from Jan – March 31. The regular application fee (\$100) begins April 1. With a completed application, a spot in the upcoming year's class will be held for returning students until Jan 31. On Feb 1, all new and returning applicants will acquire a class spot in the date order of their completed application. Class spots are secured once acceptance letters are sent to each student. This year, we have moved our re-enrollment application to PowerSchool Enrollment, and you will reapply in your parent portal. 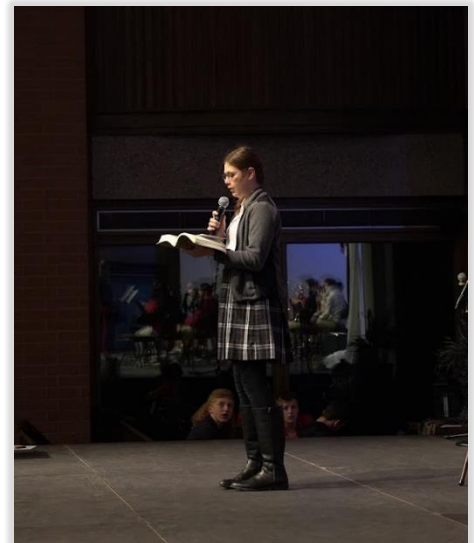

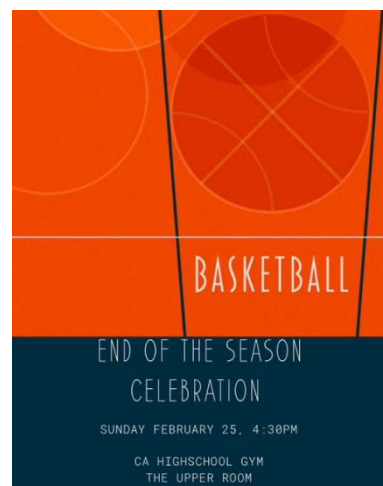
