2024-25 School Year Applications: *Please note Re-Enrollment information below* Applications are now open for new and current students in Early Childhood (preschool aged) – grade 12. Note: Early bird application fee (\$75) is open from Jan – March 31. The regular application fee (\$100) begins April 1.

With a completed application, a spot in the upcoming year's class will be held for returning students, until Jan 31. On Feb 1 all applicants, new and returning, will acquire a class spot in the date order of their completed application. Class spots are secured once acceptance letters are sent to each student.

Power School Instructions on How to Add a Sibling

Log on to your account Click on Account Preferences (left side column at the bottom) Click on the 'Student' Tab Click on 'Add' (Right side) Type in the student's name, access ID, access password, and choose the relationship (This information was sent in a letter previously) Click 'OK' Your child's name should show up on the top with your other child Please let us know if you need help.

The mobile app: if grades are not showing, try uninstalling and re-installing the app on your phone. The district code is WXBH. Don't have the mobile app? Go to your app store and look for PowerSchool Mobile with this logo. Make sure to get the dark background.
