



Collegedale Academy Offers Algebra I this Summer for Rising Freshmen

This summer, CA offers Algebra I for rising freshmen to accelerate their math skills, providing more advanced options during their junior and senior years.

Class Schedule:

The class will be held from May 20 to June 28, 2024. It will be taught by CA math teacher Bud Sinigaglio from 8:00 AM to 12:10 PM, Monday through Friday. The class will not meet on Memorial Day, Monday, May 27, 2024. (Note: If your school has not ended prior to the start date of the Algebra I class, please get in touch with Mr. Sinigaglio so we can work out a solvable solution for your student.)

Eligibility:

Each student interested in taking this class must have a teacher recommendation sent to Mr. Sinigaglio. Recommendations can be emailed or phoned at - <u>bsinigaglio@collegedaleacademy.com</u> or 303.915.1515.

To reserve a spot:

A non-refundable deposit of \$200 is due May 10, 2024. The total class fee is \$615. The total balance of \$615 is due by the first day of class (May 20).

All payments can be made at the CA business office or online once a student has applied to CA for 9th grade. "Pay Online "is found on <u>CA's webpage</u> on the very top red bar. Please make the online payment under the "Summer Algebra" line.

Please note: Due to the additional cost incurred, student accounts must be cleared, or a payment plan should be in place to participate in this class.

The class requires a minimum of 10 students, with a cap of 20 (first come, first served). Students completing this course must still take four years of high school math (Tennessee state law).

Taking Algebra I before a student's Freshman year allows a student to maximize the math options at CA. This can provide a student with math classes that allow for a deeper understanding of math and potentially improved ACT math scores.
