The school faculty will attempt to assist the student and parents in following the plan as outlined to minimize

potential exposure to allergens. However, parents and students must recognize that the school cannot control every scenario that might result in such an exposure. Thus, it is extremely important to have procedures in place in the event of an allergic reaction.
