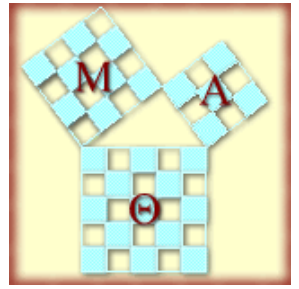


# Mu Alpha Theta Honor Society

Dear Students:

Thank you for your interest in joining the Mu Alpha Theta Honor Society at Collegedale Academy High School. The Mu Alpha Theta Honor Society organization was formed in our school to foster interest, develop substantial scholarship, and promote the enjoyment of mathematics. The society is officially a National High School and a Two-Year College Mathematics Honor Society formed in 1957; thus, we will follow the general guidelines already set. However, as a Chapter, we will make independent regulations and activities.

### ***To Join the Society:***

Students must go through an application process. Students must be eligible to apply to the society. The requirements are as follows:

- Students must be in grades 9 -12
- Student must have completed Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 and be enrolled in a higher math class such as Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus, or College Level Statistics (dual enrollment)
- Students must have an overall GPA of 3.0 and an overall *math* GPA of 3.5

### ***Membership:***

Students accepted into the Collegedale Academy Chapter of Mu Alpha Theta will be required to remain in academic good standing and serve others and the chapter. Mu Alpha Theta is a HONOR society; therefore, all members are expected to maintain an honorable character at all times. ANY honor-related offense will be grounds for immediate dismissal. Members are expected to participate in the chapter's activities and uphold the society's philosophy. These activities include, but are not limited to:

- ❖ **Attendance at monthly meetings**
  - Members must attend *all* meetings. Two unexcused absences may result in exclusion from the society. You must contact the sponsor or member officer if you cannot attend a meeting.
- ❖ **Math Tutoring Community Service (A total of 10 hours per school year)**
  - Members must tutor in math for 5 hours each semester, totaling 10 hours. Five of the 10 hours should include tutoring in the Math Tutoring Center after school.
  - The tutoring must be signed by a teacher who is aware of your tutoring.
- ❖ **Dues**
  - **\$50 one-time membership registration fee for each student joining the chapter.** The membership fee will be applied to your school bill, and you will participate in our Induction Ceremony during Chapel on September 5.
- ❖ **Special Activities**
  - Math Tutoring
  - Mu Alpha Chapel
  - Pi Day Activities/STEAM Expo
  - Other activities to be decided upon by the club membership.

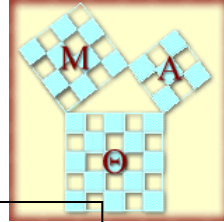
## Mu Alpha Theta Honor Society Student Application Form

### ***Procedure:***

- Complete the application form and return it to Mrs. Beasley or Ms. Andersen.

- The Mu Alpha Theta sponsors will review applications, and students will be notified through email letter of their acceptance into the Honor Society.
  
- Criterion for acceptance include the following:
  - Overall GPA of 3.0
  - Mathematics GPA of 3.5
  - Provide above-average references from at least two teachers who have taught the student within the last year. One of these references must be from a **mathematics** teacher.
  - Commitment to upholding the society's philosophy, which is “to stimulate interest in mathematics by providing public recognition of superior mathematical scholarship and by promoting various mathematical activities.”
  - Commitment to provide service to the Collegedale Academy Community in mathematics.
  
- There will be an induction ceremony for those accepted into the Mu Alpha Theta Society. The date of the ceremony will be announced. All members are expected to attend the induction ceremony.
